



St Mary's Church, Hook with Warsash Book of Remembrance Entry Application

St Mary's has introduced a beautiful Book of Remembrance, which is on display in the church, for the names of our loved ones who have died. Names are listed by month and the pages are open at the current month (in the future we may display a fortnight or week or day at a time.) The church is open during the day. A loved one's name may be entered in the Book for one of three reasons:

- a. Their ashes are interred in the Garden of Remembrance at St Mary's, Hook with Warsash;
- b. Their remains are buried or interred elsewhere in the graveyard of St Mary's, Hook with Warsash;
- c. Their remains are buried, interred or scattered elsewhere but they, or the applicant, have had an association with St Mary's or the wider Parish of Hook with Warsash.

Each entry will be identified by one of three different symbols according to these categories so please circle (a), (b), or (c) above, as relevant. The date of the entry in the book will normally be the date of death unless another particular date is requested. All entries into the Book are made at the Vicars' discretion.

We ask for a suggested minimum donation to St. Mary's of £25.00 per entry. Gifts given to St. Mary's in memory of a loved one will be used for the development and maintenance of a new Garden of Remembrance in the East of the Churchyard for the interment of ashes, and for the maintenance of our beautiful church and churchyard.

Please give your contact details first. Forms will be retained for historical information about the loved ones remembered in our Book of Remembrance.

A separate application is required for each entry. Please use BLOCK CAPITAL letters.
